The St. Mary's boys' basketball team completed a 10-0 district record with a 51-13 win over Northwood-Lena for Senior Night while the Lady Tigers fell 56-44 to Northwood.

The Lady Tigers (12-18, 2-6 in 3-1A) sit 16<sup>th</sup> in the power rankings following Friday's loss as they try to secure the final home playoff game slot.
