

Lady Tigers use productive outs to edge LaSalle 6-4

The St. Mary's Lady Tigers' softball team edged the LaSalle Lady Tigers, 6-4, Tuesday afternoon in the District 3-1A opener at SMH.

The Lady Tigers (6-5, 1-0 in 3-1A) trailed 4-3 going into the bottom of the fifth. SMH's Joelee Savell and Anna Grace Mabile led the inning off with back-to-back singles. Moments later, Grace Wren drilled an RBI single to center scoring Savell tie the game at 4-4.

Kennedy Griffin then hit an RBI groundout to second to score Mabile. Mallory LaCaze then hit a sacrifice fly to make it 6-4 Lady Tigers.

Wren pitched a complete game for the Lady Tigers throwing all seven innings, allowing six hits, one earned run, one walk and six strikeouts.
