

The Natchitoches Central boys' basketball team defeated Richwood, 60-54, Friday before losing to Northwood-Shreveport, 64-58, Saturday in the DeRidder Tournament.

The Chiefs (11-2) played five games in six days, all away from home. NCHS picked up road wins at Pickering, Winnfield and Anacoco prior to the tournament.

On Friday, Logan Smith led the Chiefs with 23 points while Harold Remo, Ja'Dell Demery and Jaden Braden all chipped in with double digit points totals to aid the Chiefs in the win over Richwood (11-5).

Saturday, the Chiefs were handed just their second loss of the season by Northwood-Shreveport (6-5) which snapped an eight-game winning streak. NCHS was paced again by Smith with 23 points while Demery added 11 points and 14 rebounds.

Natchitoches Central also welcomed Cam Davis back to the lineup who missed the first 12 games of the season after breaking his leg on Oct 20 during a football against Parkway. Davis scored nine points in his season debut.
