

Lady Tigers route Northwood-Shreveport 12-0 at Stanley Tournament

LOGANSPORT, La. - The St. Mary's Lady Tigers' softball team continued the hit parade in a 12-0 win over the Northwood-Shreveport Lady Falcons Friday in the Stanley Tournament.

The Lady Tigers (4-1) scored nine runs in the first inning sending 14 batters to the plate. SMS recorded seven hits in the inning including five singles, a double and a triple.

Malorie LaCaze led the way with two hits while six different players tallied one hit. Sophomore Kennedy Griffin and senior Brooklyn Townson both had two-RBI singles as the Lady Tigers cruised to another win.
