Chiefs host Central-Baton Rouge in second round of playoffs

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The seventh-ranked Natchitoches Central Chiefs' baseball team will host the 10th-ranked Central-Baton Rouge Wildcats in the best-of-three series beginning Thursday with game one at 6 p.m. and game two Friday at 6 p.m. Game three will be Saturday at 1 p.m. if necessary.

The Chiefs (23-7, 9-5 in 1-5A) finished the season winning four in a row with two wins over Byrd, one over Airline and the other over Delhi Charter.

NCHS will look to ride a dynamic pitching staff in the postseason that allowed three runs or less 18 times in 30 games. The Chiefs were 16-2 in games they allowed three or less runs.

The Wildcats (24-8, 8-2 in 4-5A) finished runner up in their district behind Catholic-Baton Rouge (31-2, 9-0 in 4-5A). The Wildcats are coming off a win over 23rd-ranked Zachary (19-16, 5-4 in 4-5A) in the first round sweeping the three-game series with 8-0 and 9-6 wins.

Lindsey is expected to start game one with Guillet going in game two.

The winner of the series will take on the winner of second-ranked West Monroe (25-7, 9-1 in 2-5A) and 15th-ranked Chalmette (28-5) next week in the quarterfinals.
