

Lady Tigers roll to doubleheader sweep of Huntington

NATCHITOCHEs, La. - The St. Mary's Lady Tigers swept a doubleheader from the Huntington Lady Raiders winning Game 1, 16-1, and

The Lady Tigers (15-9) jumped out in game 1 as they scored 10 runs in the first inning without recording a hit. They drew six walks, got hit by a pitch four times while Huntington (3-15) made two errors.

In the second inning, the Lady Tigers added six more highlighted by a three-run double by eighth-grader Macie Cameron and RBI single by sophomore Rayanna Norsworthy as SMS cruised to the win in Game 1.

Grace Wren and Norsworthy three scoreless innings with Norsworthy striking out all six batters she faced.

In Game 2, the Lady Tigers jumped out to a 4-0 lead as Alayna Rachal led off the bottom of the first inning with a double while Joelee Savell walked. Cameron then smacked a two-run double to center. Moments later, Chloe Methvin drilled an RBI double to left before Ady Rhodes line an RBI triple to center.

In the bottom of the second, Cameron cleared the bases again as she drilled a three-run double to the center field wall scoring Kennedy Griffin, Rachal and Savell. Moments later, Cameron scored on a wild pitch making 8-0. Later in the inning Grace Watson hit a two-run double to left while Rachal ripped an RBI triple to center as SMS swept the doubleheader.

Cameron finished with eight RBIs combined in both games. Rachal was 2-for-2 with three runs scored and an RBI in Game 2. Norsworthy threw all three innings and struck out five and walked one.

Next up, the Lady Tigers will take on Stanley Thursday afternoon at 5 p.m. on the road in non-district action.
