

The St. Mary's Tigers and Lady Tigers both picked home wins Friday night in district 3-1A basketball action over Logansport with the Tigers rolling to a 62-20 win while the Lady Tigers hung on for a 54-49 victory.

The Lady Tigers (10-13, 1-1 in 3-1A) played with just six players suited up Tuesday but got huge nights from the 'trio of Avas.' Ava Errington scored 22 points, grabbed seven rebounds and dished out seven assists. Ava Holland has a monster night under the rim with 14 points while snatching 22 rebounds. Ava Hebert added 19 points as "the Avas" scored all 54 points.

The Tigers (16-5, 2-0 in 3-1A) won their eighth straight game as they jumped out to a 16-3 lead to start the game and led 24-10 at halftime. In the third quarter, SMH put the game away outscoring Logansport 19-3 to open a 43-13 lead. The Tiges were led by Aiden Warren with 19 points while Ben Bienvenu had 14. Mixon Bankston scored 11 points as he surpassed 1,000 career points as a Tiger joining Warren who accomplished the same feat two weeks ago.

Next up, the Tigers will face a daunting challenge Saturday afternoon when they host 5A Jesuit (19-3) at 2 p.m.

The next doubleheader is Tuesday on the road when the Tigers and Lady Tigers face Northwood-Lena Tuesday night.
