

Doyle scores 15 runs in fourth to beat SMS 20-3

SHREVEPORT, La. - The Doyle Tigers scored 15 runs in the fourth inning to beat the St. Mary's Lady Tigers, 20-3, Saturday morning in non-district softball action at the Calvary Tournament.

SMS (10-8) fell behind 5-0 going into the bottom of the third but scored three runs in the inning to get back in the game. Tyonnah Burton drew an RBI walk before Kennedy Griffin single home a run with another one scoring on error to make it 5-3 Doyle.

But in the fourth inning, Doyle sent 20 batters to the plate as 15 runs crossed highlight by 10 hits. Doyle (14-5) also took advantage of five walks by SMS in the inning and an error leading to SMS's fifth consecutive loss.

St. Mary's finished with five hits as Macie Cameron, Burton, Griffin, Malorie LaCaze and Jenna Sklar each had one. Doyle collected 18 hits for the game which included five doubles and two homeruns.

Next up, St. Mary's tries to end the slide as they play at Huntington Monday at 5 p.m. in non-district action.
