

Chiefs' second half comeback not enough in 42-35 loss to Benton

BENTON, La. – The Benton Tigers edged the Natchitoches Central Chiefs, 42-35, holding off a furious rally from NCHS Friday night in District 1-5A action.

The Chiefs (2-4, 1-2 district 1-5A) trailed 34-14 at halftime and appeared to be heading for a long night. But NCHS, under first year head coach Jess Curtis, had other ideas.

NCHS scored the first points of the second half as Zion Thompson scored on a 6-yard touchdown run to make it 34-21 in favor of the Tigers. Later in the third quarter, Natchitoches Central's Kelton Howard scored on a 21-yard run straight up the gut to cut it to 34-28 BHS.

The Chiefs took a 35-34 lead with 6:01 to go as Dillon Braxton took an end-around handoff to the right side turning the corner for a 23-yard touchdown run followed by Mateo Restrepo's point after attempt.

However, Benton (2-4, 1-2 district 1-5A) responded with their only points of the second half scoring on a 26 -yard touchdown reception with 2:46 to go. NCHS would turn it over on downs on the following possession inside their own 40-yard line allowing Benton to get in victory formation and kneel the clock out.

Next up, the Chiefs continue district play as they host Captain Shreve (5-1, 3-0 in district 1-5A) Friday night at 7 p.m. in Turpin Stadium. CSHS defeated Airline, 60-35, snapping the Vikings 8-game district winning streak Friday night.
