

<u>Tigers Sweep doubleheader from Northwood-Lena</u>

The St. Mary's Tigers' baseball team swept a doubleheader from the Northwood-Lena Gators winning Game 1, 8-1, and rolling in Game 2 to a 25-0 win Tuesday at home.

In Game 1, SMH's Nathan Slaughter pitched a complete game as he allowed just one earned run, four hits and struck out 12. While the Tigers (12-6, 4-0 in 3-1A) managed just five hits, they took advantage of five Gators' errors and four walks. The SMH offense scored one run in the first, two in the third, one in the fourth, three in the fifth and one in the sixth.

In Game 1, the Tigers' offense exploded, scoring 11 runs in the first inning on six hits as they never blinked on their way to the lopsided win. St. Mary's had 12 different players record 17 hits led by Ayden Warren with three hits. Braylon Normand, Trey Scarborough and Connor Jordan each had two hits.

Jordan finished with five RBIs while Slaughter had four and Scarborough drove in three.

Ryan LaCaze picked up the win for SMH pitching three innings and allowing just one hit while striking out four.

Next up, the Tigers take on Many (11-7) Wednesday night at home at 6 p.m.
