St. Mary's rolls past Northwood-Lena, awaits playoff opponent

LENA, La. – The Division IV Select third-ranked St. Mary's Tigers cruised to a lop-sided win Friday night on the road over Northwood-Lena 61-8 in the regular season finale.

St. Mary's (7-2, 3-1 3-1A) exploded out to a 42-0 halftime lead as they dominated the Gators in all three phases of the game. SMH's Ethan Busby scored on a 12-yard touchdown run followed by a fumble recovery in the endzone by Tate Mitchell and a two-point conversion run by Busby to make it 14-0.

Thibodaux scored again on a 60-yard touchdown run to make it 61-8 as SMH cruised to the win of Northwood-Lena (1-9, 0-4 3-1A).
