The Lakeview Gators and Lady Gators both remained undefeated in district play with road wins Tuesday night at Winnfield with the Gators pulling away for 71-56 victory and the Lady Gators cruising to a 62-46 win.

The Lady Gators (19-2, 5-0 in district 3-2A) led 15-9 at the end of the first quarter and 30-15 at halftime. Winnfield (11-10, 3-1 in 3-2A) tried to hang tough as they trailed 46-33 at the end of the third quarter. But freshman Najahe Davis scored eight in the fourth quarter to help the Lady Gators pull away. Davis finished with 16 points while Tee Washington finished with game-high 21 points. Amiya Marshall scored 11 to aid Lakeview to the win.

The Gators (20-4, 5-0 in 3-2A) were in a battle for much of the game as they led Winnfield (12-7, 3-1 in 3-2A) 31-28 at halftime and 52-46 at the end of the third quarter. However, the Gators used a game-clinching 13-1 run to end the game and open up a 58-55 advantage to a blowout. Lakeview was led by Alonzo Driver with 28 points while Dareon Joseph had 23 to help the Gators to their ninth straight win and 13th in 14 games.

Next up, the Gators and Lady Gators will take on Jonesboro-Hodge Friday at home as district 3-2A play continues.
