

Lady Tigers land six on All-District 3-1A team

The St. Mary's Lady Tigers' softball team had six players named to the All- District 3-1A team.

The Lady Tigers (16-12) got two selections to the first team as pitcher Grace Wren and infielder Tyonnah Burton earned the honors.

Wren, a sophomore, pitched 132 1/3 innings and had a 3.40 ERA with 160 strikeouts and just 48 walks. Burton hit .395 for the season and crushed eight homeruns and drove in 35 runs.

SMH had three second team selections in junior outfielder Brooklyn Townson and freshmen Malorie LaCaze and Joelee Savell.

Townson hit .333 with one homerun and 18 RBIS for the Lady Tigers while scoring 18 runs. LaCaze finished the season with 24 RBIS which was third on the team. Savell had a robust .481 average as she was 25-for-52 on the season with 11 RBIS and a team-high 26 runs scored.

Junior Anna Grace Mabile earned a spot on honorable mention. Mabile hit .270 and scored 21 runs in the leadoff spot for the Lady Tigers.
