The St. Mary's Tigers and Lady Tigers split a doubleheader Tuesday at Northwood-Lena with the Tigers winning big 48-16 and the Lady Tigers falling 46-37.

The Lady Tigers (10-14, 1-2 3-1A) hung tough with the homestanding Lady Gators (12-10, 4-0 in 3-1A) as SMH trailed 24-21 at the half. NHS, the reigning Division IV Select state champions, began to pull away as they took a 33-25 lead into the fourth quarter.
