

The St. Mary's Lady Tigers' softball team pounded out 15 hits and scored 12 unanswered runs to beat Pitkin, 15-7, Friday afternoon.

The Lady Tigers (5-3) were led by Tyonnah Burton with five RBIs. Burton smacked a two-run double in the fourth inning and crushed a three-run homer to center field in the sixth. Kennedy Griffin added four RBIs.

SMH trailed 7-3 going into the bottom of the third when the Lady Tigers began their onslaught. They scored two runs on an RBI single by Brooklyn Townson and a Kennedy Griffin reached on a error that scored Jenna Sklar.
