- The Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs play in the quarterfinals for the first time in the program's history which started in 2017. The Lady Chiefs started the season 12-0 then 15-1 under first year head coach Mindy Stokes as the team was ranked #1 in the power rankings halfway through the season. After a loss in district play, NCHS finished the regular season on a six-game win streak before beating (28) West Ouachita in the 1st round in three sets and (12) Brusly in four sets in the 2nd round to advance to the quarterfinals. The Lady Chiefs feature five seniors in Tatum Kay, Brooklyn Smith, Ehren Guidroz, Keaton Mooney, and Sherlyn Guzman.
