Lady Tigers fall 5-3 in extra innings as Sacred Heart rallies with two outs in 7th

NATCHITOCHES, La. - The St. Mary's Lady Tigers lost a tough one in extra innings to the Sacred Heart Lady Trojans, 5-3 in eight innings, Wednesday night at SMS in non-district softball action.

Starting pitcher Grace Wren was one out away from a two-shutout before the Lady Trojans' bats erupted. Wren threw all eight innings allowing nine hits, one earned run, two walks and struck out seven.
