The fifth-ranked Lakeview Lady Gators will host the 28th-ranked West St. John Lady Rams in the first round of the Division IV non-select basketball playoffs Thursday night at 5:30 p.m.

The Lady Gators (23-3, 9-1 in district 3-2A) finished the season as co-district champions with Mansfield (19-8, 9-1 in 3-2A). LHS enters the postseason winners of 10 of their last 11 games under head coach Dewaskie Fuller.
