

Lady Chiefs lose two games Saturday at Live Oak Tourney

The Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs softball team lost two games Saturday at the Live Oak Tournament falling to St. Mary's Dominican, 11-4, and Live Oak 14-3.

The Lady Chiefs (7-9) trailed 5-3 in game 1 against Dominican going into the sixth inning when Dominican scored five more runs to put the game away.
