

Lady Tigers route Northwood-Shreveport 12-1

NATCHITOCHEs, La. - The St. Mary's Lady Tigers won their softball home opener Tuesday afternoon defeating the Northwood-Shreveport Falcons, 12-1. thanks to a 10-run second inning.

The Lady Tigers (2-1) opened the scoring in the first inning as Tyonnah Burton doubled to left field to score GK Philen.

In the second inning, the Lady Tigers' offense ignited as they sent 15 batters to the plate. In total, St. Mary's had six hits, five walks and took advantage of an error by the Lady Falcons leading to the 10-run inning.

That was more than enough for starting pitcher Grace Wren. The junior pitched all five innings allowing three hits, one unearned run, three walks and four strikeouts.

The Lady Tigers finished with 10 hits led by Burton, Addy Price and Wren all with two hits. Amazingly enough, Price and Burton were the only two Lady Tigers with extra base hits as both doubled.

Kennedy Griffin, Malorie LaCaze, Brooklyn Townson and Jenna Sklar all had one hit to aid the Lady Tigers' offensive attack.
