

Tigers blow out LaSalle in district opener

Braylon Normand, Nathan Slaughter and Payne Williams drove in four runs each to lead the St. Mary's Tigers' baseball team to a 22-0 win over LaSalle Tuesday night in the district 3-1A opener.

The Tigers (8-5, 1-0 in 3-1A) sent 15 batters to the plate in the first inning as they scored 11 runs and never looked back as they finished the game with 17 hits. Normand and Williams both finished with three hits while Slaughter, Trey Scarborough and Connor Jordan each had two hits to pace the Tigers' 18-hit attack.

SMH also scored four runs in the second, six in the third and one in the fourth.

Preston Martinez pitched another complete game allowing three hits, one walk and striking out two.
