

Lady Chiefs improve to 10-0 with straight set win over Captain Shreve

NATCHITOCHES, La. – The Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs' volleyball team continue its torrid start to the season in a 3-0 (25-21, 25-14 and 25-18) win over the Captain Shreve Gators Monday night at home.

The Lady Chiefs (10-0, 1-0 in district 1-division II) have now won 22 straight sets dating back to Sept. 3 against Neville dropping the second set 28-26. Captain Shreve fell to 4-5.

NCHS was led by Tatum Kay with 15 kills, four digs and three aces. Ehren Guidroz added 12 kills. Aubryn Dawson had 17 assists while Maggie Massia added 13 to help set the table. Kendall Rhodes chipped in defensively with 10 digs.
