

Guillet dominates for Chiefs in 7-0 win over Red River

Adam Guillet struck out 12 in five innings for the Natchitoches Central Chiefs' baseball team in a 7-0 win over the Red River Bulldogs Wednesday night at home.

The Chiefs (16-3) scattered eight hits led by Kyron Payne and Dillon Braxton with two each while Brock Laird and Titus Williams combined for five RBIs.

NCHS took the lead in the first on an RBI single by Laird scoring Payne. Moments later, Williams hit a sacrifice fly to center scoring Braxton.

The Chiefs scored four more in the second as they recorded three hits and took advantage of two walks and an error. NCHS added on another run in the fourth to take control.

But it was Guillet's dominance that led the Chiefs as he allowed just one hit and two walks in five innings. He also threw 83 pitches with 57 of them being strikes. Kaidon Vallery came in relief and pitched two scoreless innings for NCHS as they picked up their fifth win in six games.

Next up, the Chiefs face the Northwood Falcons on Friday at home at 5 p.m.
