

The Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs' softball team lost two out of three games at the Pineville Tournament this past weekend.

The Lady Chiefs (3-5) lost the first game of the weekend to Dutchtown, 13-1. NCHS fell behind 9-0 as they got just two hits for the game and committed four errors.

In the second game, NCHS bounced back with an 11-9 win over ASH. The Lady Chiefs rallied back with nine runs in the bottom of the sixth to erase a 9-2 hole thanks to Skylar Braxton's grand slam. Braxton finished the game with six RBIs. Syndey Terrell pitched a complete game to help NCHS hold on for the win throwing a scoreless seventh inning for the Saturday afternoon win.

In the final game of the tournament, NCHS lost a slugfest by a score of 14-11. The Lady Chiefs held an 8-6 lead after five innings. However, Hahnville scored eight runs in the top of the sixth.

Despite the loss, Morgan Robinson finished 4-for-4 at the plate with five runs scored and two RBIs. Robinson hit a solo homerun, a double and two singles to pace the Lady Chiefs.
