

**Lady Chiefs earn eight selections to All-District 1-5A team**

The district 1-5A champion Natchitoches Central Lady Chiefs' softball team had eight players selected to the All-District 1-5A team, while head coach Jeramie Hale was named the Coach of the Year, the league office announced Tuesday.

NCHS (18-13) had five first team selections in junior pitcher Sydney Terrell, freshman outfielder Maggie Massia, sophomore outfielder Lila Robertson, junior outfielder Mallory LaCour and sophomore utility player Ehren Guidroz.

Terrell threw 105 innings with 19 starts and 21 appearances as she finished the season with a 3.87 ERA. The sophomore also hit two homeruns and drove in 28 runs.

Massia led the team in batting average (.429) and hits (36) in the leadoff spot. The freshman also scored 27 runs. She struck out just six times in 106 plate appearances as well.

Robertson led the team in RBIS with 33 while hitting five homeruns and hitting .289. She was also second on the team in runs scored with 28.

LaCour finished the season with a .311 average and smacked 10 doubles with two homers and 18 RBis.

Guidroz hit .272 with two homers and 21 RBIs hitting mostly in the five-spot in the order. The sophomore also pitched for the Lady Chiefs starting eight games and faring well with a 3.83 ERA.

NCHS had three earn second team honors in junior infielders Skylar Braxton and Bre Hale and junior infielder Morgan Robinson.

Braxton hit six homers for the Lady Chiefs and drove in 21 runs. Hale hit .261 and scored 12 runs while having a .948 fielding percentage with just four errors in 69 chances. ‘

Robinson was second on the team in batting average at .368 and tied for the lead in homers with Braxton with six.

Parkway's Chloe Larry was named District MVP while Airline's Elena Hang was Most Outstanding Player.
