

**Norsworthy throws two complete games as SMS gets a pair of lopsided wins**

**TIOGA, La.** - Sophomore Rayanna Norsworthy pitched two complete games for the St. Mary's Lady Tigers Saturday at Ward 10 in Tioga as they beat the Avoyelles Public Charter Vikings 15-1 and the Avoyelles Mustangs 15-0.

The Lady Tigers (8-3) pounded out 15 hits in the first game against APC as Alayna Rachal led the way going 3-for-4 with two RBIs and two runs scored while Malorie LaCaze and AG Mabile both had two hits and two RBIs. Alyssa Brewton, Chloe Methvin and Grace Wren all had three recorded doubles for St. Mary's

The SMS offense scored five runs in the first, three in the second, one in the fourth and six in the fifth.

Norsworthy allowed just one earned run and five hits in five innings while striking out four. She threw 65 pitches with an amazing 53 of them being strikes.

In the second game, the Lady Tigers took advantage of four errors and nine walks by the Mustangs as SMS scored 10 in the first inning and five in the second to take care of business in less than an hour.

Eighth grader Ady Rhodes got the big hit of the game as she cleared the bases with a three-run double in the first inning as the Lady Tigers made quick work of Avoyelles.

Norsworthy was even better in the second game as she pitched three innings and didn't allow a baserunner while striking out five.

Next up, the Lady Tigers will host Montgomery Monday at 5 p.m. in district 3-1A action.
