Gators surge past Haughton, Lady Gators slip to Haughton

CAMPTI, La. - The Lakeview Gators and Lady Gators basketball teams split the season-opening double-header with Haughton Monday night at home with the Gators winning, 70-59, and the Lady Gators falling 49-39.

In the first game, the Lady Gators fell behind 24-15 in the first half before storming back on a 16-1 run between the end of the second quarter and early third quarter to take a 31-25 lead. However, Haughton responded with a 16-1 run over their own to retake a nine-point lead as the Lady Gators went eight minutes without a field goal. Lakeview was unable to close the gap to less than seven in the final 5:30 of the game as Haughton picked up the win.
