

Lady Tigers dominate Logansport 15-5

NATCHITOCHEs, La. - The St. Mary's Lady Tigers crushed the Logansport Lady Tigers in district 3-1A action Wednesday at SMS by a score of 15-5.

The Lady Tigers (5-2) jumped out in front with three runs in the first inning as Grace Wren doubled and scored on error before Kennedy Griffin smacked an RBI single. Malorie LaCaze hit a sacrifice fly later in the inning to give SMS a 3-0 lead.

After Logansport scored a run in the second, St. Mary's scored four more in their half of the inning as Wren singled to score AG Mabile. Another run scored for SMS as Griffin reached on an error to score Joelee Savell before Tyonnah Burton blasted a two-run homer making it 7-1.

St. Mary's continued to pile it on with three runs in the third and fourth in the fourth to take a monstrous 14-1 advantage before closing the door with a 15-5 win.

Wren and Griffin led the way with three hits each while Burton had two hits and three RBIs. LaCaze finished with three RBIs as SMS had 11 hits.

Wren threw a complete game allowing seven hits, five earned runs, one walk and five strikeouts.

Next up, SMS will play Byrd Thursday at home at 5 p.m.
