The Natchitoches Central Chiefs and Lady Chiefs split a basketball doubleheader with Captain Shreve Tuesday night on the road as the Lady Chiefs picked up the win by a score of 60-41 while the Chiefs lost by the exact same score.

The Lady Chiefs (13-7, 2-1 in 1-5A) snapped a three-game losing streak but had to fight for it. NCHS led CHS (7-8, 0-2 1-5A) just 19-17 at halftime and 30-24 at the end of the third quarter. However, the Lady Chiefs erupted in the fourth quarter for 30 points to pull away. NCHS was led by Alyssa Chandler with 16 points and 10 rebounds while Makayla 'Tootie' Gallien scored 16 points as well.
