

The St. Mary's Tigers and Lady Tigers swept a doubleheader on the road over Quitman Tuesday night with the Lady Tigers winning 65-61 in overtime and the Tigers 63-43.

The Lady Tigers (4-7) held off Quitman in the first half of the double header as senior Ava Errington scored 23 points to lead all scorers. Lybi Cross added 15 points while Ava Holland and Ava Hebert had 12 and 11 points, respectively.

In the second game, the Tigers (6-2) came out on fire as they drilled 11 first half three-pointers and led by as many as 27 before cruising to the win.
