



St. Mary's tabs Kendrick Moore as Boys' Basketball Coach

NATCHITOCHEs, La. - St. Mary's High School has hired Kendrick Moore as varsity boys' basketball head coach, the school announced Tuesday.

Moore, a native of Montgomery, Louisiana, was an assistant coach at Lakeview from 2011-2014 under head coach Josh Hancock and current Gators' head coach Brian Williams. Moore helped the Gators to a pair of state runner ups finishes in 2012 and 2013.

Moore, 37, also was a head coach at Grant High School from 2017-18.

Moore was also an assistant coach at Calvary from 2019-2022 where they finished state runner up three years in a row.

After his stint at Calvary, Moore was hired as head coach at Menard before taking last year off

Moore replaces former SMH head coach Jake Bankston who took the job at Benton High School as boys' basketball head coach.
