

Lakeview falls to DeQuincy in first round, but breaks 22-year drought

DEQUINCY, La. - The Lakeview Lady Gators were defeated, 20-2, in the first round of the Division IV non-select softball playoffs by the ninth-ranked DeQuincy Lady Tigers Thursday afternoon.

The Lady Gators started well as Carlie Spears singled to center to start the game then Hailey Jarnagin reached on an error. Later in the inning, Addison Robinette lined a two-run double to give LHS the lead.

However, the Lady Tigers (16-14) scored 12 runs in the first inning and eight in the second as they took advantage of 12 walks by Lakeview pitching and scattered five hits.

Isobel Christor had the other hit for Lakeview as the Lady Gators got their first runs in a playoff game since prior to 2003 (no records of games prior to '03 are available on the LHSAA website).

DeQuincy advanced to the second round against an opponent to be announced.
