

The Lakeview Gators and Lady Gators swept Montgomery on the road Thursday in non-district basketball action with the Gators winning, 48-31, and the Lady Gators 48-39.

The Lady Gators (13-1) extended their winning streak to 13 games in the first game as Timberlyn Washington scored 22 points to lead the way for Lakeview. The Lady Gators were tested, however, as they led just 22-21 at halftime and 32-30 at the end of the third quarter before pulling away in the fourth quarter. Montgomery (10-5) came into Thursday's game with a nine-game winning streak.

In the second game, the Gators (12-4) bounced back nicely after the tough loss to Alexandria at home, 49-47. The Gators suffocated Montgomery to 31 points while using a balanced offensive attack where nine different players scored led by Taylen Phillips with 10 points.
