

Tigers win fourth straight with win over Caldwell

The St. Mary's Tigers' baseball team took advantage of six errors from the Caldwell Parish Spartans as the Tigers picked up an 11-3 win Tuesday at home.

The Tigers (6-2) scattered eight hits led by Braylon Normand who was 3-for-4 with a run scored and two RBIs. Connor Jordan aided St. Mary's going 2-for-4 with two runs scored and an RBI.

Despite falling behind 2-0, St. Mary's kept the pressure on Caldwell by scoring in every inning but the sixth. The Tigers scored a run in the first, two in the second, three in the third, three in the fourth and two in the fifth.
