

Wren's 16 K performance highlights two wins for Lady Tigers

The St. Mary's Lady Tigers' softball won two games at the Tioga Tournament Saturday as they routed Bunkie, 16-2, and shutout Avoyelles 3-0 behind a 16-strikeout gem from Grace Wren.

The Lady Tigers (9-5) exploded for 18 hits in game one led Joelee Savell with three hits. Wren, Brooklyn Townson, Tyonnah Burton, Kennedy Griffin, Mallory LaCaze and Addison Price all had two hits two aid the 18-hit barrage. SMH scored four runs in the first, fouhe r in the fourth and eight in the sixth.

In Game 2, it was all Wren in the circle. She allowed just one hit, one walk and struck out 16 Avoyelles hitters. The Lady Tigers scored two runs in the first on an RBI double by Wren and an RBI groundout by Townson. Burton added some insurance as she drilled an RBI double to left making it 3-0 in third inning.

That was more than enough for Wren as she retired 19 out of 20 hitters to end the game after a one-out single in the first.
